

# STUDY/INTERN ABROAD – GERMANY

## UNIVERSITY OF ROCHESTER-SPONSORED PROGRAMS

### **SUMMER PROGRAM**

#### **GERMAN IN GERMANY (UR – MODERN LANGUAGES & CULTURES)**

A four-week course offered in Berlin. Students attend language courses at the *New Schule* and live with a host family. A University of Rochester professor directs excursions and cultural events. Requirements: at least 2 semesters German or equivalent. Applications are due in early March. ### **SEMESTER/YEAR PROGRAMS**

#### **COLOGNE EXCHANGE (UR – MODERN LANGUAGES & CULTURES)**

A full-year program at the University of Cologne for selected juniors and seniors. Students attend courses in the Humanities, Natural Sciences and/or Social Sciences at the University of Cologne while teaching one English course at the university. Requirements: at least 4 semesters of college German. Applications are due in early December. #### **BONN / COLOGNE / BERLIN INTERNSHIPS (INTERNSHIPS IN EUROPE PROGRAM)**

Politics, law, arts, media, psychology, social science, and business internships are offered, along with two academic courses. Requirements: at least 4 semesters German. Also available in summer. Internships in Europe program.

#### **BERLIN (IES)**

Students take a combination of Institute and Humboldt University courses in German. One or both semesters; minimum 4 semesters college German; 5 semesters required for spring students. Courses available in Humanities, Natural Sciences, Engineering, and Social Sciences.

#### **BERLIN METROPOLITAN STUDIES (IES)**

Using Berlin as a case study, this program examines social and cultural issues relevant to major cities today. Through interdisciplinary courses, students study topics such as Cultural Identity, Gender and Sexual Politics, Multiculturalism, and Urban Studies. Field study trips provide a comparative context for the program. No previous German language study is required.

#### **FREIBURG (IES)**

Students take a combination of Institute and University courses in German. One or both semesters; minimum 4 semesters German; 5 semesters required for spring students. Courses available in Humanities, Natural Sciences, and Social Sciences.

#### **FREIBURG E.U. (IES)**

An English-language program offering coursework in business, economics, political science, and German. Requirements: background in economics, modern European history, international relations, or comparative government.

#### **VIENNA, AUSTRIA (IES)**

English-language, semester- or year-long programs offering a wide variety of courses. No prior German language study is required although participants take German while on the program. Courses available in Humanities, Natural Sciences (in German), and Social Sciences.
