University of Rochester's campus emergency notification system

AlertUR has the capability of delivering short messages to e-mails, cell phones, and other devices. AlertUR is a tool that supplements the University's existing means of communicating with students, faculty, and staff before, during, and after an emergency situation. **Undergraduate students in the College of Arts, Sciences, and Engineering and at the Eastman School of Music are currently part of the system.** We plan to expand the system to include other members of the University community in the coming academic year.

We encourage you to check your personal data online at <http://www.alert.rochester.edu/> and add additional numbers and update your e-mail address. Additionally, the AlertUR website provides a frequently-asked-questions page.

The University has a highly trained staff of safety and security professionals as well as comprehensive policies and procedures to deal with emergencies. No one can guarantee a perfectly safe environment. We take every opportunity to remind students about being responsible when it comes to personal safety. For example, walking or running with someone rather than alone after dark, being familiar with one's surroundings, and using well-lighted, heavily-traveled routes should be on everyone's safety checklist.

Because no single means of communication is effective in every situation, the system used by the University has multiple communication modes and adds redundancy to our other channels of notification and communication. AlertUR is a valuable tool for making contact when short messages and instructions can make a difference.

UNIVERSITY IT SECURITY

One of University Information Technology's primary goals is to maintain the security and proper functioning of our computing resources. In order to meet this goal, we continuously check for the newest threats that are posed to the network and its users while also enhancing our security procedures to reduce potential risks and effectively manage problems as they arise. We also strive to keep you well-informed because prevention is the key to security. With your help, the University of Rochester's digital information and technology resources can be safe for everyone.

TOP 10 WAYS TO KEEP YOURSELF SECURE

1. **File-Sharing** – Avoid peer-to-peer (P2P) networks and disconnect any file-sharing clients already installed on your system.
2. **Multiport Devices** – Don't install multiport network devices (wireless routers, switches, hubs, etc.) in your residence hall room.
3. **Keep Your Computer Updated** – Keep your computer's software up to date, including your anti-spyware software and ensure you have installed the University's Antivirus to keep your computer safe.
4. **Lock Your Computer** – When leaving your computer unattended, physically lock it to prevent theft and make sure the screen is locked with password protection to safeguard data.
5. **Log Off Public Computers** – When using a public area computer, be sure to completely log off when you are finished using it.
6. **Create Strong Passwords** – Create strong passwords that combine at least eight letters, numbers, and symbols.
7. **Scan Email Attachments** – Scan all email attachments before you open them since they may contain viruses that could harm your computer.
8. **Keep Personal Information Safe** – Never respond to emails asking you to disclose any personal information. The University will never email you asking for your personal information.
9. **Back Up Important Data** – Make backup copies of your important computer data, store them securely, and consider storing extra copies at another location.
10. **Limit Social Networking Information** – Protect your social networking presence (such as on Facebook) by limiting the disclosed amount of personal identifying information.

GETTING CONNECTED...

TO THE WIRED NETWORK

- An ethernet cable is necessary in order to connect to the ResNet system. The cable (CAT 5/6 RJ-45) can be purchased from University IT Computer Sales. It is recommended that you observe the potential layout of your residence before purchasing any cables, as the available lengths vary.
- Locate the available network ports in the residence. Each room has one port for each occupant of the room.
- Plug one end of the cable into the ethernet port on your computer. Plug the other end of the cable into the provided wall jack in your residence.
- Turn your computer on.
- Open a web browser (Firefox, Safari, Internet Explorer). You should be automatically directed to the ResNet Registration Page. If not, navigate your browser to: **<https://reg.resnet.rochester.edu>**
- Complete the online steps from the ResNet Registration Page.
- You will be prompted to reboot your computer.

TO THE WIRELESS NETWORK

A wireless Network Interface Card (NIC) is necessary in order to connect to the wireless network. URWireless service is available across many areas of campus and ESM. A site map is available at: **<http://www.rochester.edu/its/wireless>**.

The University has provided (2) network identifiers to support wireless service:
UR_RC_Internal and **UR_RC_InternalSecure**.

UR_RC_InternalSecure is recommended. This network provides the highest level of wireless security currently available at the University.

- Open a web browser (Firefox, Safari, or Internet Explorer). You will be automatically directed to the University wireless login Page. (Password needed for UR_RC_InternalSecure access). The password is **URWireless**.
- Login using your NetID username and password.

TO THE STUDENT PORTAL **(MY.ROCHESTER.EDU)**

The student portal provides you with easy access to materials for many of your courses (including their River Campus library electronic reserves), information about your One Card accounts and transactions, ability to deposit money via credit card into your One Card accounts, and access to your University e-mail account. It also includes quick links to many academic and campus services web sites and news about upcoming campus events. Visit <http://my.rochester.edu> and log in now for access to your portal site.

TO EMAIL

In order to provide a consistent and easy-to-use convention for email addresses throughout the University, faculty and staff can request mail forwarding so that email sent to `firstname.lastname@rochester.edu` will be forwarded to their department email mailbox.

Faculty or staff should use the NetID login protected page:

<https://it.rochester.edu/rochedualiaspages/UserLogin.aspx>. You will need to enter your NetID and password. A confirmation email will be sent to your email mailbox; requiring that you send a reply. Once that process has been completed, you will be able to use your new `firstname.lastname@rochester.edu` as a mail alias.

Students may also use this email address convention. Because the University provides students with advertisement-free University branded Gmail accounts, there is a procedure that creates a `firstname.lastname` alias to the student's Gmail account.

Whether you are faculty, staff or student, you **do not** need to reconfigure your email reader (eg Eudora, Outlook Express or Netscape Messenger) or re-subscribe to any email-based mailing lists.

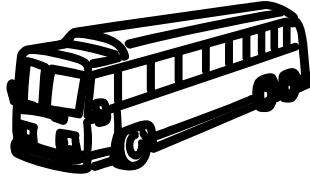

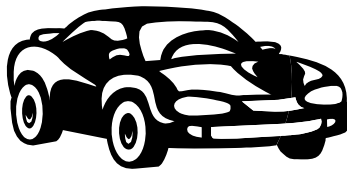
TO THE ZIPCAR SERVICE

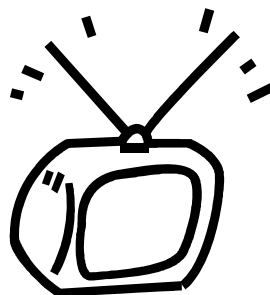

TELEPHONE SERVICE

Student living centers and residence halls are equipped with courtesy telephones on each floor; you'll also find courtesy telephones in many of the academic buildings on campus. The telephones are each marked with their 5-digit extension.

On-campus dialing to other offices and telephones is 5-digit. Local service is accessed by dialing *9 followed by the 7-digit number and 800 numbers can also be used for long distance calling. Pre-paid calling cards are available in the IT Center (Townhouse). Courtesy telephones are labeled with Emergency Call Information. (Note: Saturday hours are only in effect during the fall/spring semesters and when not preceded or followed by a University or Federal holiday on the same weekend.* Saturday hours subject to change*)

Post Office Information - The Campus Post Office is a privately run station of the United States Postal Service that is staffed by University personnel. The USPS contracts the University to sell postage and money orders, and to handle special service mail such as Express, Certified, Registered, and Insured. The Campus Post Office accepts cash, UROS, and checks for payment on all services except Money Orders. Money Orders must be paid for with cash.

In order to receive mail and packages on campus, a student must have his/her own campus post office box (CPU box). Private carrier companies (UPS, FedEx, etc.) can ship directly to the student's CPU box; packages of any size cannot be sent to individual residence hall rooms. Mail is delivered to students Monday through Friday, except on University holidays. When students receive a package or piece of special service mail, an e-mail is sent to their attention. You will need to print out/or write down this information in order to pick up your package. Each email represents one package. You are not notified when mail is placed into your mailbox, so please check your mailbox often. The USPS does not deliver mail to the University on Saturdays or Federal holidays, except for Express Overnight deliveries. By taking advantage of the Intramural mail system, students can send mail to any University location, postage free.

The XXXX represents the last four digits of your box number.

Extra Services - For a nominal fee, students can send or receive faxes at the Campus Post Office, as well as send packages via UPS or FedEx. A variety of packaging supplies are also available for purchase.

1. Mail is delivered to students the same day the USPS delivers it to the University. Mail is completed by 1:30 p.m. Packages are processed as received. When you receive the email you may pick up the package immediately.
2. Never send cash, or have cash sent, under any circumstances.
3. Insurance is recommended when mailing valuable and/or fragile items.

ROCHESTER HOT SPOTS

ROCHESTER EVERY DAY (RED)

The Rochester Every Day Program (RED) is a student discount program managed by the Rochester Center for Community Leadership at the University of Rochester. The program's main goal is to provide an economic incentive for students to explore the city and patronize local companies. In exchange for offering students a discount, businesses receive free on-campus advertising support, invitations to special campus events, and a listing on the RED web site. The program is free to both students and businesses. Businesses which apply RED discounts are denoted with an (R).

UROS

URos is a flexible spending account which is available to all students. Students activate their account by indicating a per-semester deposit at the time they sign up for their dining plan or by making an initial deposit at the beginning of the academic year via cash, check, Visa, MasterCard or Discover. The URos Account is accepted at all campus dining locations but is intended for use at the Corner Store, bookstores, the Common Market, Computer Sales and Services, International Theatre, the Cinema, and for vending, copy, laundry machines, printing services, the Post Office and several off-campus venues. Businesses which accept URos are denoted with a (U).
