Master of Science (M.S.) in Community Counseling

Full-time Course Sequence – 2 Years

Courses in bold face must be taken as shown. Other courses may be taken different semesters, although some have prerequisites. Students who begin before fall 1 will have lighter semesters, but bold face courses are still taken as shown. Part-time students taking two courses per semester, including summers, can complete the program in three years plus one additional summer. Part-time students taking between three courses a year (the minimum) and five courses can complete the program in four to seven years.
