Master of Science (M.S.) in School and Community Counseling

Part-time Course Sequence – 3 Years +

Part-time students taking two courses per semester, including summers, can complete the program in three years plus one additional summer. Part-time students taking between three courses a year (the minimum) and five courses can complete the program in four to seven years.
