Full-Time Course Sequence – 1.5 - 2 Years

Courses in bold face are required. Non-bold-faced courses are examples of electives; still other electives may be substituted for these. This sequence works for students beginning in an odd-numbered year. For students beginning in the fall of even-numbered years, the program takes two years of less than full-time study some semesters. Part-time students taking two courses per semester, including a summer, can also complete the program in two years. Part-time students taking three (the minimum) or four courses a year can complete the program in four or three years, respectively.
