2007-08 Doctoral Conference Presentation Awards

Presenting at conferences plays an important role in advancing the academic careers of our doctoral students as well as increasing the Warner School's national visibility. To support this endeavor, we have instituted a new program to support doctoral students' presentations at professional conferences. These competitive awards are intended to provide partial reimbursement for travel and related expenses, and all qualified doctoral students in the Warner School can apply for them. Determination of the number and amounts of these awards is contingent on the funds available for this program each year. Awards normally will be in the \$300-500 range.

Eligibility Requirements. Applicants for these funding must meet the following conditions:

- Be currently registered as a Warner School doctoral student.
- Have formally submitted a proposal to present at a national conference to occur in the current fiscal year.
- Have completed the application procedures (below) by the established deadline (**January 10, 2008** for this first year). Late applications will be considered only if funds are still available.

Application Procedures. Information and application forms are available on the Warner School Website. Applicants must submit the following materials by the application deadline:

1. The application forms.
2. A copy of the proposal submitted for the conference presentation.
3. A formal acceptance notice from the conference (to be submitted as soon as received if not available at the time of the application).

Evaluation of Applications and Fund Distribution. The award committee (comprising of faculty representing each of our three program areas) will evaluate applications meeting the eligibility requirements utilizing a combination of the following main criteria:

- The quality of the conference and thus its strategic value for increasing the Warner School's and applicant's visibility.
- The potential value of participating in the conference for the applicant, given his/her career goals and stage in the program and the role to be played in the presentation.

- The applicant's need for this financial support (full-time students on assistantships will be given priority).
- The extent to which the award will allow us to maximize the impact of our limited funds (an evaluation based on the efforts made by the applicants to reduce costs and leverage other funding, as well as prior funding given to the applicants).

Awards will be announced promptly following final committee decisions, but no later than **January 31, 2008** this first year. In cases where the conference proposal has not yet been accepted by the time of the award, the award will be contingent to receiving such acceptance, and will be forfeited if the conference proposal is eventually rejected.

Requests for reimbursement need to be submitted to Ed Morgan or Patty Peters, Warner School Finance Office, Dewey 2-160D, preferably within two week from the end of the conference, but no later than **May 15th**. Late requests will **not** be honored because of the university fiscal year submission deadlines.
