Activity periods will include small group instruction in baseball, basketball, soccer, track, archery, football, tennis, volleyball, etc. and the daily Swim program. They will also include organized game activities. During the Free Activity Period, campers may attend the activity of their choice.

It should be noted that the overall schedules of the two sessions will not be a duplication of each other. While some of the instruction will be repeated, it will allow for progression in skill levels within each area. The special events are a continuous program which will offer a variation in topics from Session I to Session II.

### PARENT'S DAY

The final day of each camp session (July 17, July 24) will be parent's day during which all parents are invited to attend any or all of the day's activities.

### CAMP T-SHIRTS

Each camper will receive one T-shirt at the beginning of the camp session. For purposes of identification, we request that all campers wear their T-shirts daily. Extra T-shirts are available for \$7.00 in the camp office. Sun screen, hat and water bottle are also items that we highly recommend.

### SWIM PROGRAM

Children should bring a swim suit and towel for the daily swim program. A swim lesson will be given during one of the four activity periods each day. Children will be tested the first day to determine the level of their swim ability and grouped accordingly. This is required by New York State law. An additional recreational swim opportunity will be given during free time each day.

### TRANSPORTATION / ATTENDANCE

If your child will not be attending camp on a particular day, we would appreciate knowing this ahead of time (especially on opening day). All campers must be **signed in and signed out with a staff member**. Please be prepared to show a picture ID. If anyone other than a parent is transporting your child (ie. Carpooling, babysitter, Aunt, etc.), please notify us ahead of time.

While we expect everyone to have a good camp experience, the camp does reserve the right to dismiss any camper whose presence may be found detrimental to the camp.
