# CAMP DIRECTORS

Over the past 5 years, Rochester Softball has been on a steady incline, each season proving better than the last. One constant over these past few seasons has been, now head coach, Margaret Yerdon. She assisted the Yellowjackets to a 33-12 finish for the 2008-2009 season, setting a single-season victory record for the third consecutive year. In addition, the Yellowjackets made their third straight NCAA Division III playoff appearance. The Yellowjackets took second place in the competitive UAA Conference and repeated as the Liberty League Champions for the third straight year, posting a perfect 8-0 record. A very impressive eleven players were named All-Liberty League and five received All-UAA honors. Beth Ameno and Lindsay Macaluso, who will be returning as a junior, earned First Team NFCA All-Region honors. Kate McLean and Kim Grimes, in only their first season as Yellowjackets, earned NFCA All-Region honors as well. Team highlights include Ameno becoming only the second Yellowjacket to earn NFCA All-American honors. She was also named First Team All-UAA and First Team All-Liberty League, as well as Liberty League Pitcher of the Year. On the mound Ameno finished 23-9, appeared in 35 games, struck out 254 batters in 201.1 innings and posted a 1.25 ERA. Shortstop Lindsay Macaluso was named the Liberty League Player of the Year, First Team All-Liberty League, and First Team All-UAA. Kim Grimes was named the Liberty League Co-Rookie of the Year, First Team All-Liberty League, and First Team All-UAA. Katie McLean and Juliana Nicholson received Second Team honors in both leagues and six other players earned honors as well.

Coach Yerdon was a pitcher for Binghamton University, where she is still the career record holder in strikeouts (431) and earned run average (1.40). Yerdon earned Division II NFCA All-Region honors in 1999 and was the NECC All-Conference Pitcher of the Year in 1999 and 2000. In 2002, she earned America East All-Conference honors. Following graduation in 2002, Yerdon served as a graduate assistant pitching coach at Binghamton University, before joining the Rochester softball staff in 2004. Yerdon is joined by Assistant Coach, Jena Robertson. Robertson, a former Yellowjacket, earned NFCA All-Region honors all four years. Following graduation in 2007, Robertson served as a volunteer assistant coach for the Yellowjackets.

## CLINIC INFORMATION

### 6 v 6 Indoor Games November 15<sup>th</sup>

**Schedule:** Games will be approximately 75 minutes. Games will begin at 8am and the last game will start at 2pm.

#### **Pre-registration fee due by November 1st:**

- \$20 per individual/ \$125 per team (must consist of at least 6 players)
- Teams that bring more than 9 players will have to pay \$10 for each additional player.
- Teams interested in playing more than one game can register for the second for \$100

**\*Application must be postmarked on/before pre-registration date of November 1<sup>st</sup>. After this date, the fee will increase to \$150 per team or \$30 for individuals. The second game will be \$125. Games will be reserved on a first come basis. Game time will only be held with registration and payment.**

Each team must have a minimum of 6 players to participate, but are permitted to bring up to 9 players without any additional fees. Due to the size of the facility the outfield area is limited; however, teams may bring more than six players and play with outfielders if they choose to. If a team has fewer players than the team they are playing, our University of Rochester players can fill in where they are needed. In regards to scheduling, we appreciate teams being flexible as to when they are able to play. We realize that some teams are traveling and we will do our best to take this into consideration and schedule accordingly.

## 6 v 6 FORMAT

Rochester's indoor turf facility gives a great outlet to teams that are eager to work on game situations and face live pitching in a competitive setting. Teams will be given 75 minute time slots to play another team in their age group. Each team will also be provided a warm-up of 30 minutes, prior to their game time. Games will follow ASA rules, ground rules will be provided by umpires before each game. Space is limited sign your team up today!

- The game time for each team will be limited to 75 minutes.
- Games will be played with free substitution
- Each player must have a consent form signed by a parent or legal guardian
- Umpires will be provided
- No Cleats
- Teams must provide their own equipment
- Players may sign up individually or by team
