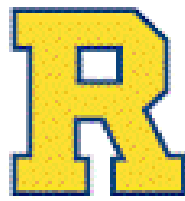

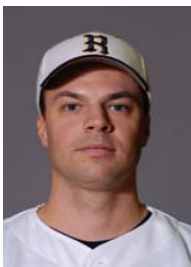

Coach Profiles

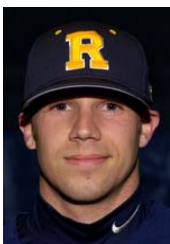
Head Coach— Joe Reina

Day Camp July 20-23

The Day Camp is designed to provide young players, ages 8-18 years old, with an opportunity to improve their skills in all facets of the game. Players will experience college-type practice sessions and receive instruction from current University of Rochester staff, as well as top high school coaches from the area. Live games will be organized and players will compete in games that are coached and officiated by the camp staff. Players will be exposed to multimedia presentations on topics such as hitting, pitching, defensive play, strength and speed training, and the college recruiting process. Includes a camp shirt and dining center lunch.
