On-campus Recruiting Options:

- **Job and Internship Postings:** Submit internship and post-baccalaureate positions for posting in our online database, CareerLink (powered by Experience), and candidates will apply to you throughout the academic year or based on your pre-set timeframe.
- **Fall and Spring Career and Internship Days:** Attend our on-campus recruiting fairs on Wednesday October 7, 2009 and Friday February 19, 2010.
- **On-Campus Interviewing:** Promote your organization and interview on our campus! Schedules can easily be arranged.
- **Resume Collections:** Provide a job description and a deadline date, and the Career Center will collect resumes and send them to you by e-mail, fax, and/or postal mail by your desired date.

Off-campus Recruiting Programs:

Career and Internship Connections (CICs): January 2010

- Held in DC (January 4, 2010), Los Angeles (January 5, 2010), New York City (January 6, 2010), Chicago (January 7, 2010), and Boston (January 8, 2010)
- **Free** pre-screened consortium interview events with schools including Cornell, Boston College, Brandeis, Emory, Johns Hopkins, Pomona College, Notre Dame, and Washington U. in St. Louis.
- These events bring the students to you - minimizing the time and expense of travel.
- The morning of the event is an open career fair and the afternoon features pre-arranged interviews.

Co-sponsored Business Recruiting Programs:

The University of Rochester Career Center pairs with the Simon School of Business twice a year to offer employers the opportunity to recruit full-time and internship candidates in New York City.

New York Minute: October 2, 2009

- Held in early Fall, employers conduct pre-arranged interviews with undergraduates and/or graduate students for full-time positions in business, finance and consulting.

New York Recruiting Program: January 29, 2010

- Held in January, employers conduct pre-arranged interviews for summer internship opportunities in the fields of business, finance and consulting.
