



All College faculty are welcome to an @mail.rochester.edu University email account. If you get an account @mail.rochester.edu, ITS provides the following services to you:

**WebMail** - The ability to check your mail from anywhere using only a browser. (<https://mail.rochester.edu>)

**WebRFM** - Browser-based access to file storage of up to 100MB. Access through a WebDAV client is also available. (<http://mail.rochester.edu/>)

**Spam control with Pure Message** - An automated system for recognizing SPAM and either marking it before it comes to your mailbox or quarantining it so it never gets delivered. (<http://www.rochester.edu/its/email/spam/>)

**@rochester.edu** - This provides you with the ability to create an alias, first.last@rochester.edu, that forwards your email to your regular account. (<http://www.rochester.edu/its/rochedu>)

**NetID** - Everyone at the University is assigned a NetID and needs to use this for various University-sponsored services. For example, wireless access is made available through use of the NetID. The @mail.rochester.edu account has its password synchronized with your NetID. Human Resource Management System (Peoplesoft) requires NetID for access to your data, including records of pay and benefits management. (<http://www.rochester.edu/its/netid>)

**Web Forums** - Using your NetID, you can participate in discussion groups with others at the university. Note - these are not recommended as class discussion forums - see WebCT instead (<http://webct.rochester.edu>). (<http://mail.rochester.edu>)

Your department may provide you with an account on its own server. If you choose to use that account, you may still participate in the @rochester.edu, Net ID and Web Forums services.
