# WRITING CONSULTANTS

- Our motto is: All writers need readers! (Especially for high-stakes writing.)
- Consultants are from a variety of disciplines.
- We can help at any stage of the process (from the prompt to polishing).
- We're not subject experts, editors, or proof-readers. We are trained academic readers. We are a resource for strategies.

### A TYPICAL APPOINTMENT

Sessions are based on your goals & questions

#### Consultants can help with:

- Discovery (e.g., Figuring out what to include/exclude)
- **Focus** (e.g., What is your purpose? Is this central message getting through clearly?)
- Cohesion (e.g., Are there gaps in your narrative? Missing information/connections? Do sentences and paragraphs connect across the text?)
- **Structure** (e.g., Does the text demonstrate reader-based organization? Does it meet expectations for given-new and end-focus?)
- Polishing (e.g., Is the text free of errors? Does the style work for this purpose/audience?)
