Winners will be announced at the end of May and prize money will be awarded at that time. Winners will be honored at the Annual Ethics and Humanities Grand Rounds Dinner (usually held in the Fall) and award plaques will be presented at that time. Winners' names will be added to the Cluster award plaques on display in the corridor adjacent to the Miner Library. With permission, winning entries will be displayed in a case at the entrance of the Miner Library.
