E. THE APPLICATION PROCESS

- Application deadlines for new proposals are due ***no later than April 1***. Senior Scholars projects must be approved no later than the first day of classes of fall semester of the senior year.
- A completed application consists of:
 1. The Senior Scholars Project proposal form
 2. A resume
 3. A letter of recommendation from the intended supervising faculty advisor. This letter should be delivered directly to the Multidisciplinary Studies Center (MSC) in Lattimore 203
