

THE JANET HEIDINGER KAFKA PRIZE FOR FICTION BY AN AMERICAN WOMAN

How to Enter:

All entries must be submitted by publishers who wish to have the work of their authors that were published in the year 2008 considered.

Entries must be submitted by February 1st, and the works must have been assembled for the first time, or at least one-third of the material must be unpublished.

Four copies of each entry should be submitted.

The \$5000 prize will be awarded annually to a woman who is a USA citizen, and who has written the best book-length work of prose fiction, whether novel, short stories, or experimental writing. Works written primarily for children and publications from private and vanity presses cannot be considered. We are particularly interested in calling attention to the work of a promising but less established writer.

Only under the most unusual circumstances will a writer be considered for a subsequent award within a ten-year span.
