GENERAL PURPOSE:

BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES:

Provides counseling services under direct supervision as a member of an interdisciplinary treatment team caring for individuals with a substance use disorder and mental health disorder (MICA) and their families. This includes participation in the intake process, as well as individual therapy and group therapy as needed. Has a direct supervisory responsibility for Sr. Chemical Dependency Counselors and Chemical Dependency Counselors within the Addiction Psychiatry Service (APS). Responsible for day-to-day operations of the clinic and coordination between disciplines to ensure effective care is provided. Coordinates service along with the Clinical Coordinator of the program.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

Master's degree preferred. Minimum requirement is a Bachelor's degree in a discipline related to the human service field and three to five years of related experience in drug/alcohol dependence treatment preferred; or an equivalent combination of education and experience. NYS Credential as Alcoholism and Substance Abuse Counselor (CASAC) required.
