GENERAL PURPOSE:

BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES:

The social worker provides psychosocial assessment and psychiatric diagnosis and treatment for emotionally disturbed adult patients 18 years and older in the Older Adults Clinic and General Adult Ambulatory Clinic. The social worker functions as primary therapist and is responsible for the overall coordination and implementation of the treatment plan for patients assigned to his/her caseload. Participates on an interdisciplinary treatment team and develops liaisons with health and social agencies in the community, as well as with other health professionals within the hospital to support evaluation and treatment of the patient. The social worker also provides treatment, and crisis intervention as appropriate. May provide family treatment and case management services as indicated. Other duties as assigned.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

Master's degree from an accredited school of social work. Certification as a social worker, as defined by the State Board for Social Work, State Education Department, Division of Professional Licensing Services is required. If certification has not been obtained upon employment, the individual has 1 year within which to obtain it. 1 year in medical or psychiatric social casework.
