

Passwords are the key to your data

When choosing a password:

- Don't use passwords based on personal information that may be easily accessed or guessed.
- Don't use words in any dictionary of any language.
- Develop a mnemonic for remembering complex passwords.
- Create passwords with uppercase, lowercase, and special characters.
- Also use a combination of letters, numbers, and special characters.
- Use different passwords on different systems.
