Protect Your Smartphone

You can keep your Smartphone or PDA secure by.

- creating and using a screen lock password or PIN.
- enabling a timeout so that the device locks after a period of inactivity and requires a password to continue.
- not storing sensitive data on your device; if necessary, delete the information once you are done using it. (University employees please see your departments requirements regarding storing sensitive data.)
- disabling Bluetooth, Wi-Fi, etc., if you aren't using it.
- making sure that the phone has been wiped properly before returning or recycling it. Deleting your inbox is not good enough.

Any University owned phones should be returned to the University, not dropped into the recycling boxes.
