

## Android Configuration for UR\_Connected

Please follow these instructions.</p>	<p>Set up instructions for connecting to the Wireless Network using an Android V2.1 and higher.</p> <p>For newer versions of Android, WPA2-Enterprise is supported.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. <i>Select</i> <b>Settings</b>.</li><li>2. <i>Select</i> <b>Wireless &amp; networks</b>.</li><li>3. <i>Select</i> <b>Wi-fi Settings</b>.</li><li>4. <i>Select</i> <b>UR_Connected</b>.</li><li>5. It may ask for a "credential storage" password. This is NOT the AD user password -- it's an Android password. If the user hasn't set it up already, they may be prompted to do so at this point. If you do not know this password, you can type in any password 5 times and after the fifth time, it will clear the password.</li><li>6. <i>Select</i> EAP type: <b>PEAP</b>.</li><li>7. <i>Select</i> Phase 2 Authentication: <b>MSCHAPv2</b>.</li><li>8. Leave the CA Certificate and Client certificate fields blank.</li><li>9. For Identity, <i>type</i> the <b>Active Directory Username</b>, and Anonymous Identity should be left blank.</li><li>10. Finally, for the Wireless Password <i>type</i> the <b>AD password</b>.</li></ol>
