



Depending on the protocol for authentication (i.e. whether you use PEAP or LEAP), there are two possible entries for "User Name":

1. For PEAP, enter "ur\" followed by your domain account User Name
2. For LEAP, just enter your domain account User Name **without** "ur\"
3. If you are not sure, try option 1 first, then option 2.

Enter your domain account Password

Verify that 802.1X field is set to "Automatic"

Check the option to "Remember this network"

Click OK

Then, **UR\_Connected!**
