## Notice of Award (NOA)

The NOA is generated from our information system, UR-Coeus. It serves to provide pertinent information about an award. You will find, however, that the NOA contains much more information.

The following summary serves as a "road map" to familiarize you with NOA terminology and the information that will be important to you. Remember that all awards differ; the more complex the award, the more information that will be provided on the NOA.

The first page provides the key identifying information about the award, such as Principal Investigator, GR FAO, award number from Coeus, sponsor and sponsor award number and title of the project.

The **Budget Period** section lists the start and end date of the current period and the amount awarded, normally a budget year increment.

The **Project Period** section lists the start and end date for the entire project and provides the total estimated amount of the award (i.e., for a standard NIH grant it would be the five-year anticipated amount). The anticipated award amount is changed if there is a funded supplement or deobligation by the Sponsor.
