* This report indicates the ethnic origin of students, as reported by the students. Definitions are below.

Numbers 1-7 apply to all except those who are Nonresident aliens.

1. Asian: A person having origins in any of the original peoples of the Far East, Southeast Asia, or the Indian Subcontinent, including, for example, Cambodia, China, India, Japan, Korea, Malaysia, Pakistan, the Philippine Islands, Thailand and Vietnam.
2. Black or African American: A person having origins in any of the black racial groups of Africa.
3. White: A person having origins in any of the original peoples of Europe, the Middle East, or North Africa.
4. Hispanic or Latino: A person of Cuban, Mexican, Puerto Rican, South or Central American, or other Spanish culture or origin, regardless of race.
5. American Indian/Alaska Native: A person having origins in any of the original peoples of North and South America (including Central America) who maintains cultural identification through tribal affiliation or community attachment.
6. Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander: A person having origins in any of the original peoples of Hawaii, Guam, Samoa, or other Pacific Islands.
7. Two or More Races: Not Hispanic, more than one race category apply.
8. Nonresident Alien: A person who is not a citizen or national of the United States and who is in this country on a visa or temporary basis and does not have the right to remain indefinitely.
9. Race/Ethnicity Unknown: The category used to report students whose race and ethnicity are not known.

Totals may differ from internal University Student Information System reports. Simon Bern Executive students are included.
