Students who have resided in any country <u>other than those listed below</u> in the past 5 years must check yes in the bottom section of part 2 of the Health History and Immunization Report, enter the name of the country where they resided, and complete the Tuberculosis Test (PPD) section on page 4 of the Health History and Immunization Report.

Students entering the United States who have only resided in the countries listed below over the past 5 years are not required to have a tuberculin skin test.
