

2008 United Way Campaign Investments to the University of Rochester

Nine University sponsored programs receive **investments** directly from the United Way Community Fund to enrich the University's community outreach. All funds received in the annual campaign reach community programs. None covers overhead or campaign costs. This year, University programs received over \$1.6 million from the United Way, providing substantial programmatic support.

With **designated** funding, UR will receive over \$1.63 million from the 2008 United Way campaign, as follows:
