## **FAQs**

- 1. Q: Vicki Aspridy When will we be looking at the **Simon admissions systems?** When/how will that information come over to UR Student?
  - A: Julia explained that we are currently in those discussions and working with Workday to determine exactly what we need to bring over from Admissions systems in order to effectively create the student record in UR Student. We will be using a portion of the Workday admissions module, but only as much as we need in order to create the student record effectively.
- Q: Will UR Student replace the online working report?A: Yes
- 3. Q: **SON Fall registration** starts around July 7. Do they rush registrations in SIS early or do it via the new system?
  - A: We will meet with Andrea to figure this out
- 4. Q: **ECMS has fall registration** in May, as do other schools within UR. What will happen to these reservations?
  - A: We will convert all registrations from ISIS into UR Student and then make a clean cutover. There may be a short window when double entries are required, but the UR Student team will work with Registrars to create this plan

- 5. Q: Lena What about **Simon moving from quarters to semesters?** We want to make sure the UR Student team is aware of this.
  - A: Julia explained that we have had several meetings with Simon (Vicki Aspridy) and we are waiting for state program approvals to come through so that we can formalize more of our plans for the change from quarters to semesters.
- 6. Q: Joanne King How we will see semesters, quarters and divisions in UR Student?A: We will see Academic Unit (AU), Academic Level (AL), etc. A data dictionary is included below and will be provided to help staff understand new terminology (website, communications and training).
- 7. Q: Terry There are two different degrees at the graduate level at ESM (master of arts and DMA). How will that be grouped in UR Student? You had mentioned it is related to billing? A: Any Program of Study (POS) that has a Masters credential will be in the Master AL. Same for Doctoral Any doctoral credential will be in the doctoral AL. The R&R side is based on credential. Billing will follow what is built on the R&R side.
- 8. Q: Lena Cardone What about the **Au Passant master's degree**? How will this program be handled? A: We will be able to grant these and WD is working on "what if" technology that will help schools identify these students.
- 9. Q: How will **ECMS** fit in AU/AL structure? Can Non Matriculated (NM) student work toward a POS credential?
  - A: ECMS has its own AU/AL structure. Under ESM and the AL is ECMS NM
- 10. Q: John Will **Take Five program** will be a primary POS when the student is in their fifth year? A: We are still working out how the fifth year programs will fit into the program of study ecosystem.
