Introduction

- The academic record for a student is organized around one or more programs of study
- In UR Student, a program of study is *not* the detailed list of courses that a student has completed
- UR Student Programs of Study are tracked in several different places in ISIS
 - Major Codes
 - Minor Codes
 - Instruments
 - Clusters
 - Degrees (for things like certificates and en passant degrees; added directly to the degree screen for a student vs coming over from the program line)
- Programs of study were created in UR Student not only to be able to convert all of our history, but also to take advantage of the features and functions of the Workday Student software
- UR Student has more guardrails around programs, and how and when they can be used
- Programs of Study will be maintained by the UR Student Support Center, but it is important that key users across all Academic Units understand how they are built and what they control in the system



UR Student Program of Study is identified by it's textual name and code

- Designed with an intuitive naming convention for UR Student and Data Warehouse reporting
- Simplification and Clean Up where necessary
- The Program Area attribute will be used to track Discipline (humanities, social sciences, natural sciences)
- Educational Credentials (Degrees) are awarded by the system only at the completion of a program of study, they cannot be added to a student directly

Program of Study Code Structure:

- Leveraged our SIS legacy structure + benefits of new system
 - School Code
 - Degree
 - Major Code (from SIS)

Concept:

School Code_Degree_ISIS Major Code

E.g., For a student who has a declared Mechanical Engineering major from Hajim, their program code would look like this

- Is categorized by:
 - Academic Unit UR School and/or Department
 - Academic Level Undergraduate, Graduate, Medical or ECMS
 - Program of Study Type Categories of program areas that follow specific logic
 - And other Codes CIP, HEGIS/NYSED, CGS taxonomy codes for reporting purposes
- Provides the following functionality within UR Student:
 - Academic requirements for students
 - Academic policies applied to students
 - Educational credentials that students can earn
- Every student will have a program of study in UR Student, even if they are not pursuing an educational credential here at UR, e.g.:
 - Non-Matriculated Students
 - Visiting Students



- Programs of study are viewed in the system by their Program Name
- You can click on the "twinkie" (B to the right of the program name) to view the preview of a Program to see the more detailed code
- This is very helpful where we have multiple programs of study with the same name

Program of Study Categories

- Every program of study type must be associated with a Workdaydefined program of study category
- Program of study categories are not typically seen on UR Student screens, but control system processing and requirements.
 - Can a student be accepted for admission under this program?
 - Can the program be a student's only educational objective at completion?
 - Can the program be used to confer an educational credential (degree)?
 - Does the program represent supplemental requirements to their official program of study (can be added as an optional additional program)?
 - Does the program represent an area of focus within an official program of study (must be selected along with the parent official program)?
- The following slide includes a matrix of how each program of study category supports these rules

Tracking Undeclared Students – AS&E Undergrads

- The Official flag on a student's program line in ISIS defines if a student's program of study is declared ('Y') or undeclared ('N')
- Understanding a student's 'intended' major is an important part of institutional reporting; the system also needs to understand when a student has declared a major
- UR Student will utilize a parallel set of programs of study to help delineate between a declared/undeclared program for a student
- Students will move from the Intended to the actual program of study at the point of major declaration
- 'Intended Majors' will have an "I" in the Degree code section to delineate from declared programs



NEW – Program Focus

- Program Focus A parent program that groups areas of study within UR Student for reporting and future functionality
 - Students will have both the Parent and the Program Focus program of study assigned to their Academic Record
 - Any one student can have only one program focus for a single parent program of study (only one concentration within Simon for a PhD)
 - A program focus can relate to only one parent program
 - If "Program Focus is required" is set to Yes for a program, the focus must be known at entry

Code structure is brand new for the parent program only

- Applied Music
 - The Parent Program would be Applied Music (06_BM_AMU)
 - The Program Foci would be:

• Admissions Systems (Slate, etc.) would pass the code for the Program Foci to UR Student (in this case, as an instrument), and UR Student will assign the Parent Program along with the focus

Program of Study Design Rules

- The "Official" category of programs in UR Student will only include programs approved by the State of New York
 - This will not include Minors, Clusters, Instruments, Non-Matriculated, Visiting Students
- The Program Name will be the name under which the program was approved by NYSED
- Certificate of Achievement (CoA) and Certificate of Advanced Achievement (CAA) are not always approved by NYS. They can only be earned in combination with an approved program
- At the undergraduate level, programs that share the same NYSED code will be created as a Parent Program (new code) with Program Foci. Program Foci can apply to one and only one parent program
- Auxiliary programs were used in lieu of program foci if a student needed to be able to have
 - More than one additional area of study associated with the primary program (minor, cluster, instrument, specialization)
 - The area of specialization can be applied to more than one parent program (e.g., an area of specialization can be added to all masters level programs within an area)

Program of Study Design Rules

- While we will convert all programs in the SIS for a student, we will only bring the first program of study or academic interest from a student's application in Slate, Apply Yourself or another admissions system into UR student as part of the first go live (February 2020)
- Programs that were not actively registered with NYS were not re-created
- There are some programs of study being created for the purpose of supporting conversion due to the existence of data in ISIS, but they will be end dated for entry just after our go live. These programs will show up in the Program of Study report, but can no longer be assigned to students.

Program of Study – What programs can you combine vs complete independently?

- In UR Student, the system controls which program types can be combined for a student within an academic record, as well as which program types can be completed at a different time (e.g., an en passant Masters, etc.)
- These controls are defined at the Academic Unit and Academic Level and are established on a student's primary program of study
- This is sometimes referred to as "addable" or "stackable"
- A complete definition of the setup per school and level is included in the Appendix

Reporting on Programs of Study

Key Program of Study Fields:

- Owning Academic Unit the school
- Coordinating Academic Unit the academic unit that processes approval transactions for a program (change of program, major declaration, etc.) (see appendix)
 - School level Simon, EIOH, ESM, SMD-Graduate Studies, SON, ECMS
 - Academic Department/Program level Arts & Sciences, Hajim
 - Home Department level Warner

A student must have a 'primary' program of study

- The Owning Academic Unit of the student's primary program of study ties a student to a school and academic level
- Programs of study are organized into Academic Records, which define a student's degree pursuit at the University of Rochester.
 - Academic Records can have multiple programs of study; one must be identified as the primary program of study
 - Academic Records are 'active' until a student graduates (completes) or withdraws.
 - If a student was both an undergraduate and a graduate student, he/she would have more than one Academic Record



Reporting on Programs of Study - Understanding Program of Study Status

Each program of study within a Student's Academic Record has a status:

Program of Study Status	Description	Academic Record Status
Matriculated	The student has been admitted, but has not yet started in the program of study. Set when the application is received by UR Student	Active
In Progress	The student is active in the program. This date is equal to the default declare date for a newly admitted student, which is the first date of the academic period in which the student entered the program	Active
Leave of Absence	The student has been approved for a leave of absence from the institution. All active programs of study within the academic record are set to this status when the leave is approved. Begins on the leave start date. The status will change back to In Progress for all programs on the leave return date. <i>Students cannot register for any coursework while in this status</i>	Active
Discontinued – one program of study	The program of study has been dropped by the student but the student has not withdrawn from the institution as a whole. This would be commonly seen when an undergraduate declares a major and the BA, BS or BM undergraduate major is added to the academic record and becomes the primary program of study, and the intended major is discontinued.	Active
Discontinued – all programs of study within the academic record	If all programs of study are set to a discontinued status, the student is not longer actively pursuing a credential and the academic record moves to Inactive Status	Inactive

Reporting on Programs of Study - Understanding Program of Study Status

Each program of study within a Student's Academic Record has a status, cont.:

Suspension ** use of this status is still under evaluation **	The student has been suspended from the institution for a specified period of time, for either academic or non-academic reasons. All active programs of study within the academic record are set to suspended status when the suspension is processed on the suspension start date. <i>Students cannot register for any coursework while in this status</i>	@ Suspension Date: Inactive
	As of the return date, programs of study return to In Progress status and the Academic Record returns to Active	@ Return Date: Active
Dismissal ** use of this status is still under evaluation **	The student has been dismissed from the university for either academic or non-academic reasons. The student is not expected to return, and the academic record is set to Inactive status	Inactive
Pending Completion	The student has applied for completion and is in the process of being reviewed. This status can be set independently for a program of study within a record if that program of study type can complete independently from the other programs of study in the record	Active
Institutional Withdrawal	The student has been withdrawn from the institution. All active programs of study within the academic record are set to this status when the withdrawal is approved. A new academic record must be created in order to a student to return from Institutional Withdrawal	Inactive
Complete	The student has graduated from the U of R. If all programs of study for the student are complete (or discontinued), the academic record is set to inactive status. If the student continues to pursue a another program of study within the academic record, the academic record remains active. For example, a Doctoral student who receives an en passant Masters would have a Masters program in a status of complete, but would also have a Doctoral program in progress within that academic record, and the academic record would remain in active status.
