### Overview of CCAS

- CCAS is involved in students' academic lives from Orientation through post-college programs
- Activities of particular interest to freshmen
  - Program Planning: Rochester Curriculum
  - Advanced Placement and International Baccalaureate credit

### Advising

- Pre-Major Advisers
  - Meet with new students during August orientation to help plan for the first semester and beyond
  - PMAs help students set academic goals and connect advisees with other resources on campus
- Professional Advisers (Lattimore 312)
  - Provide general advising as well as specialized support
  - All River Campus undergraduates encouraged to access our services
  - Four Hajim School advisers





### Advising cont'd

#### Major Advisers

- Students are assigned to an adviser in their department once they declare their major
- Hajim School advisers stay with their advisees all four years

#### Peer Advisers

- Help students navigate academic policies and procedures, make connections with faculty, review research opportunities, and explore study abroad and options for independent and interdisciplinary study
- Represent various departments across disciplines



### Special Academic Opportunities

#### Fifth Year Enrichment Programs:

• The <u>Take Five Scholars Program</u> and <u>Kauffman Entrepreneurial Year</u> (KEY) offer students the opportunity to enrich their undergraduate experience with a tuition-free fifth year
