#### Rochester Curriculum

Students must satisfy each of the three academic divisions:

- Humanities
- Social Sciences
- Natural Sciences and Engineering

At minimum, students will complete one major and two clusters

# Majors and Minors and Clusters (oh my!)

- Majors typically require 12-14 courses
- Minors typically require 5-6 courses
- Clusters 12 credits in total; typically 3 courses

(Engineering and transfer student requirements may vary)



### Special Circumstances

- Double Majors: Two majors/ONE degree
  - Economics + English major = one B.A.
- Double Degrees:

Two or more majors/TWO degrees

- Microbiology (B.S.) + Anthropology (B.A.)
- Mathematics (B.S.) + Chemistry (B.S.)
- Double degrees require 136 credits
- Overlap Policy

### Steps to Declare

- Review departmental websites
- Outline a tentative course plan
- Print your record from Blackboard

- Obtain blue major declaration form in Lattimore 312
- Arrange an appointment with appropriate faculty member
- Each department has authorized faculty who may approve your major or minor

#### Tips for Meeting with Faculty

- Schedule a time or use office hours
  - Don't just drop in
- Not sure how to make an appt?
  - · Talk to dept. administrator or check web site
- Introduce yourself
  - Be prepared with questions
- Ask about their interests:
  - Why did you choose to study this discipline?

#### Questions for Faculty

- What is the upper level writing requirement?
- What is the Transfer credit policy?
- When are departmental events for majors?
- Any special opportunities?
  - <u>Undergraduate Research</u>, TA jobs
  - Independent studies

#### Deadlines:

Plan to declare your major by early April of sophomore year Some financial aid (i.e.TAP) may be jeopardized if not declared by early junior year

- Undeclared juniors will be reclassified to sophomore status in the spring
- Take Five/KEY/ Study Abroad eligibility
