- Potential volunteer roles include:
 - Greeting and checking-in guests at on-site registration.
 - Greeting and scanning guests at individual events.
 - Dropping off and/or picking up floral arrangements or event signage.
 - Monitoring tent entrances.
 - Assisting with kid-friendly activities.
- Most importantly, Meliora Weekend is about having fun and connecting with the greater University of Rochester community, so we are looking for volunteers who embody this mindset!
