

Club Sports & Policy New Club Expectations

During each evaluation of a prospective new Club Sport, the Club Sports Council & Caucus will evaluate the group based on the following criteria. If these criteria are met and discussed, the group will proceed to be reviewed by the Policy and Review Committee.

1. Club fits under the umbrella of Club Sports
2. Club is insurable under the Catastrophic Insurance Policy (no liability issues)
3. Club presents a novel, distinct club that does not already exist at U of R
4. Club has demonstrated communication with current Club Sports Advisor
5. Club has demonstrated efforts to secure a faculty advisor for the club & communication with that advisor
6. Club has opportunities to compete representing the U of R (other schools, community clubs, etc.)
7. Club is open to all university undergraduates (not exclusive)
8. Club has filled leadership positions – President & Business Manager at the very minimum
 - a. Note years of officers
 - b. Officers understand their responsibilities to the club
 - c. Future potential leadership to succeed any graduating members
 - d. Discussion of a coach/trainer/cense if necessary
9. Club has demonstrated there is interest on the campus (potential members of varying years) by holding a general interest meeting (& obtained the contact information of those interested in joining/supporting)
10. Club discusses equipment and secure storage of equipment
11. Club discusses need for practice space and competition space
 - a. Discuss guaranteed practice time is 2 times for week for 2 hours through Goergen Athletic Center
 - b. Discuss membership policy for graduate members and community members
12. Club discusses funding & fundraising and its potential future uses
13. Club has a clear, thorough Constitution that follows the template provided by S.A, & Club Sports
