2. Chapters that have incorporated a new position for the EE and take advantage of FSA and advisory resources have fared much better than those chapters who have not.
3. The Format of a chapter's plan and report are important. The EE document should be easy to read and to see the different aspects of the plan. Easy to read = Easier to accomplish.
4. Setting deadlines and dates in the plan helps to accomplish goals.
5. The best rule of planning is "Who, What, Where, When, Why, How."
