Women's Softball Constitution

Article I. Purpose

The purpose of the Women's Softball team is to compete against other colleges and universities to the best of our ability in competitive games. In order to improve upon the skills of our members, practices will be held on a regular basis throughout the season.

Article II. Meetings

- A. An interest meeting will be held at the start of each semester to attract new members to the team, and to inform previous members of the details of the upcoming season.
- B. Meetings and practices will also be held throughout the Fall and Spring semesters.

Article III. Membership and Voting

- A. Membership
 - 1. All University of Rochester undergraduate, graduate students and community members are eligible.
 - 2. Due to the costs involved, a membership fee may be required which is to be established at the start of each year.
 - 3. Active members attend 2 or more events per semester and have paid any required membership fees.
- B. Voting
 - 1. Voting on any issue is official only if a majority of the active members are present.
 - 2. All members have one vote on a given issue.
 - 3. Issues being voted on will be decided by the majority decision of the active members of an official meeting.

Article IV. Officers and Qualifications

- A. There shall be three executive officers every year the president, club sports representative and business manager. The nominees must be active members of the team, and they must be members of the Student Association in order to qualify to run for office.
- B. Executive Board positions can be amended in this constitution following the same procedure as the adoption of the entire constitution.
- C. Duties of Officers
 - 1. All officers shall actively recruit new members.
 - 2. The president is responsible for the following:
 - a. Overseeing the proper operation of the Women's Softball
 - b. All communication and transaction with outside parties.
 - c. All communication and transaction with the Student Association.
