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## Get Inclusive: Title IX Required Training

All student leaders are required to complete the Get Inclusive training, provided through the Title IX Office, by October 30th. The training consists of 20-minutes for sexual misconduct and about 60-minutes for diversity, equity, and inclusion for students. All student leaders should have received an email from Get Inclusive with information on how to complete the training.

If you are participating in the [Medallion Leadership Program](#), you can receive a Civic Engagement workshop by completing the [Level 1 Workshop Reflection](#) form.

**Organizations with officers who do not complete the training by the October 30th deadline, will have their VEMS access revoked.**

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## TapRide App Updates

Effective September 30th, the TapRide app will no longer be used as the University's method for requesting on-demand rides through the [Safe Ride](#) system. A new ride app, which integrates with a new GPS app for the University shuttle system, will launch soon. Until the new app launches, students should call the Safe Ride dispatcher number (585) 276-RIDE (7433) to request a ride. Students will request a ride through the dispatcher and the dispatcher will relay the ride information to the driver. Safe Ride runs from 11 p.m. to 4 a.m. every day during the academic year (except for breaks and University holidays) to provide safe and reliable transportation for undergraduate students.
