NARAYANA KOCHERLAKOTA is the Lionel A. McKenzie Professor of Economics at the University of Rochester. He received a bachelor's degree in mathematics from Princeton University and a doctoral degree in economics from the University of Chicago. Kocherlakota has previously held academic appointments at Stanford University, Northwestern University, the University of Iowa, and the University of Minnesota. He has published more than 50 articles in a wide range of fields, including monetary and financial economics. He served as a member of the Federal Reserve's monetary policy committee from 2009-15. He is an active public commentator on economic policy.



**CLIFFORD W. SMITH, JR.,** is the Louise and Henry Epstein Emeritus Professor and Emeritus Professor of Finance and Economics at the Simon School. He received a bachelor's degree in economics from Emory University and a doctoral degree in economics from the University of North Carolina-Chapel Hill. Smith joined the Simon Business School in 1974, for over 45 years he was on the front lines working to forever change the world of corporate finance and Simon. He has published 16 books and more than 90 articles in leading finance and economic journals. He has won 37 Superior Teaching Awards, and in 2018, the executive MBA Superior Teaching Award was renamed in his honor.



SEVIN YELTEKIN is the 8<sup>th</sup> dean of the Simon Business School. She is also the *Frontier Communications/Rochester Telephone Professor of Business Administration and Economics*. She oversees the administrative and academic functions of the school, shapes the school's vision and priorities, and serves as the leading advocate of its faculty, programs and students working with alumni, the business community and other external constituencies. Before joining University of Rochester in July 2020, she was a professor of economics at Carnegie Mellon's Tepper School of Business from 2005-2020. She also held the Rohet Tolani Distinguished Professorship and served as the Senior Associate Dean of Education at the Tepper School from 2017-2020. Prior to Tepper, she was a faculty member at the Kellogg School of Management at Northwestern University.

Dean Yeltekin is a highly respected macroeconomics scholar, and is well-known for her research that spans fiscal policy design, social insurance design, computational economics and asset pricing implications of macro policy. She received her bachelor's degree in economics and mathematics from Wellesley College, and master's and PhD degrees in economics from Stanford University.
