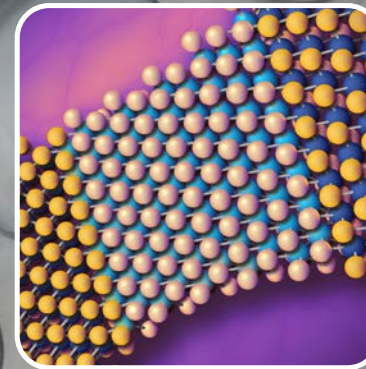
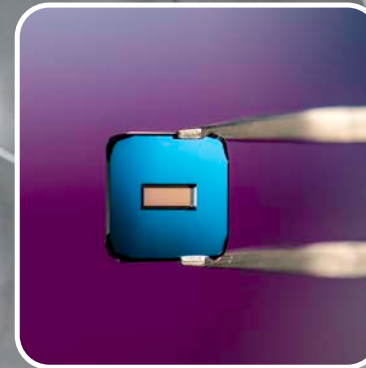
## THE LABORATORY FOR LASER ENERGETICS (LLE)

is home to the two largest laser systems found at any academic institution in the world. LLE is a world-class research facility renowned for its groundbreaking work in frontier science, inertial confinement fusion, high-energy-density physics, laser technology, and plasma physics. Led by a team of award-winning scientists, researchers, and engineers, LLE has made significant contributions to the field, including groundbreaking research that earned the Nobel Prize in Physics in 2018.



## THE INSTITUTE OF OPTICS

was the nation's first optical science, engineering, and design program and has granted more than half of all degrees in optics ever awarded in the United States. It has produced many high-tech optics, laser, photonics, and imaging innovations and companies.

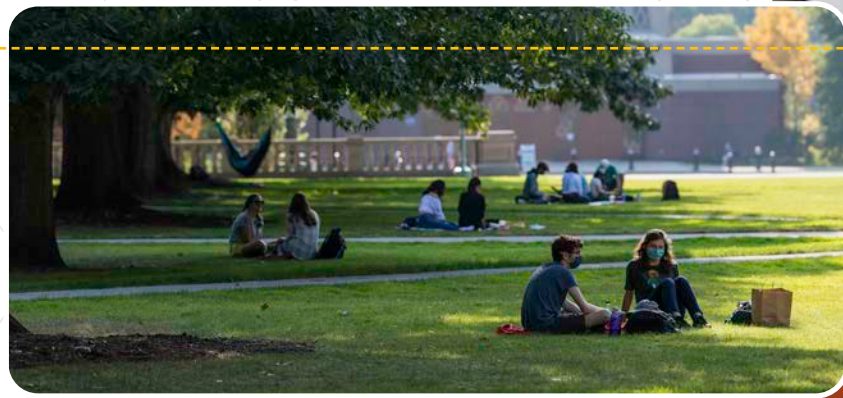

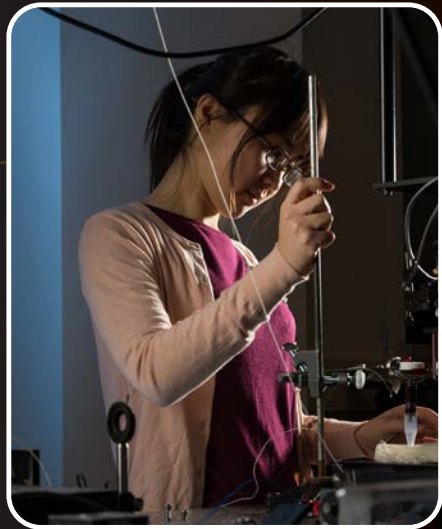

The University of Rochester's School of Medicine & Dentistry has a rich history of groundbreaking research and medical advancements that have significantly improved global health.

**Cancer Vaccine**

University of Rochester researchers contributed to the development of the human papillomavirus (HPV) vaccine, the world's first cancer-preventing inoculation, saving hundreds of thousands of women's lives.

**Chemotherapy**

Until the 1980s, many cancer patients quit chemotherapy because of its harsh side effects. Years of research on chemotherapy-induced nausea and vomiting led URochester scientists to pioneer the concept that when these problems are adequately controlled, patients are more likely to finish a full course of cancer treatment. University of Rochester's work informed the development of the first national recommendations to doctors on controlling nausea.

**Hib and Prevnar Vaccines**

Pediatric researchers transformed child health worldwide by developing the Haemophilus influenzae type b (Hib) conjugate vaccine, virtually eliminating a leading cause of bacterial meningitis—a previously often fatal illness—in preschoolers. The University of Rochester team's breakthrough also inspired new vaccines using the same template, including Prevnar, the vaccine that protects against pneumococcal infections.

**Surfactant Therapy**

School of Medicine & Dentistry physician scientists were pioneers in administering lung surfactant to premature infants, proving its safety and effectiveness in clinical trials. This therapy, which dramatically improves survival rates, is now used worldwide.

**Glymphatic System**

The landmark discovery of the glymphatic system—the brain's previously unrecognized

waste-clearing network that becomes most active during deep sleep—was made at the University of Rochester School of Medicine & Dentistry. This finding has transformed our understanding of how the brain maintains its health and is informing the development of therapeutic strategies for conditions such as Alzheimer's disease, traumatic brain injury, and migraines.

**RNA Biology**

The Center for RNA Biology at the University of Rochester is home to one of the world's strongest groups of RNA biologists. They discovered nonsense-mediated mRNA decay—one of the major surveillance systems in the body that protects against innate mistakes in gene expression by eliminating deleterious mRNAs that could lead to the production of potentially toxic proteins that can cause disease. This and other RNA-based findings are leading to new therapeutics for a wide range of diseases that cannot currently be treated with conventional drugs.

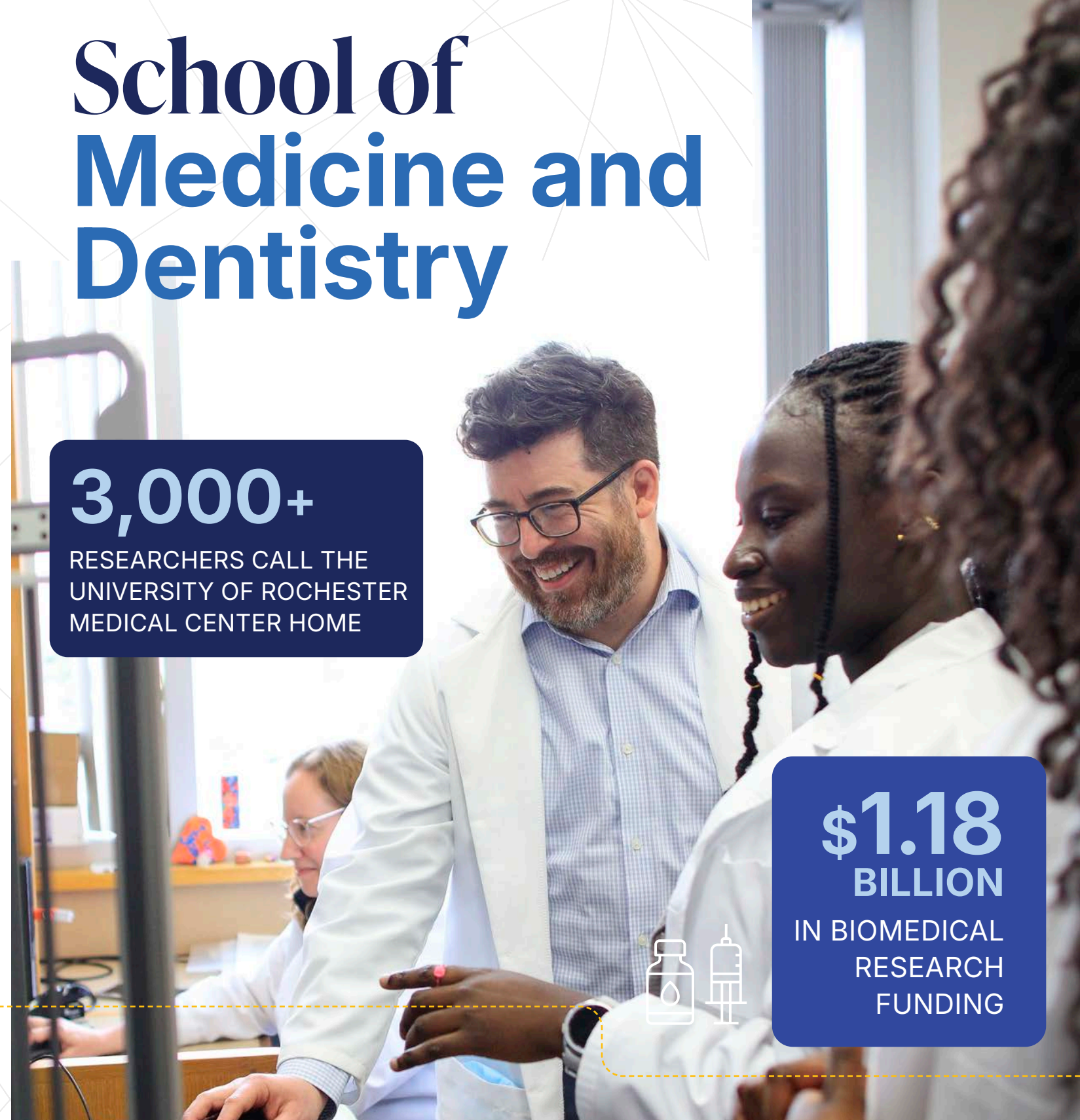
**Aging**

Internationally known in the field of comparative biology, URochester researchers investigate biological data from animals that are short- and long-lived—including naked mole rats, bats, and bowhead whales—studying the factors that are related to longer life. Home to one of only eight National Institutes of Health-funded Nathan Shock Centers for aging research in the United States, ongoing research aims to eliminate disease and make people healthier overall.

**Neurological Drugs**

The University of Rochester Center for Health + Technology has played an instrumental role in bringing 12 neurological drugs and devices to market—including landmark treatments for Parkinson's, Huntington's, and neuromuscular diseases—while pioneering new ways to design, measure, and deliver clinical trials. The center, which runs industry-grade clinical trials, is moving therapies from lab to life faster and more equitably.

The Simon Business School is known for world-renowned faculty whose research appears in leading journals and major outlets including *The New York Times*, *The Economist*, and *The Wall Street Journal*. As the birthplace of Positive Accounting Theory and the home of three preeminent journals—the *Journal of Accounting and Economics*, *Journal of Financial Economics*, and *Journal of Monetary Economics*—Simon is a leader in business scholarship and analytics. Simon was the **first full-time MBA in the U.S. to offer STEM designation** across all concentrations, offers five STEM-designated

MS programs, and is an early leader in integrating generative AI across curricula. With more than 35 years of global enrollment, international students make up 50% of the full-time MBA and over 75% of full-time MS programs, supported by 20,000 alumni in 80+ countries. Strong outcomes underpin this global reach, with Simon ranked No. 2 for ROI by *Bloomberg Businessweek* (2024), 88% of the MBA Class of 2025 employed within three months at an average total compensation of \$162,175, 98.5% securing U.S.-based roles, and 85% of MS graduates employed within six months, primarily in North America.

The School of Nursing at the University of Rochester is a nationally recognized leader in nursing education, research, and practice, uniquely embedded within the University of Rochester Medical Center — the region's leading academic health system. This close integration creates a dynamic learning health system where students, faculty, clinicians, and scientists work to translate discoveries into better care locally and globally.

Drawing on a 100-year legacy of innovation, more than 90 percent of faculty actively practice across UR Medicine, bringing real-time insights from hospitals, clinics, and community settings back into the classroom. Students benefit from immersive clinical placements across the health system, state-of-the-art simulation and virtual reality environments, and flexible pathways from accelerated nursing programs to master's, DNP, and PhD degrees in high-demand specialties.

Faculty researchers at the School of Nursing lead studies in aging, cancer, cardiac care, sexual health and HIV, and parent-child health, placing the school among the top tier of US nursing programs in National Institutes of Health funding. Their work drives evidence-based clinical practice, extending the school's impact from bedside to boardroom and from Rochester neighborhoods to international collaborations in education and practice.

We support a large and diverse population. **We host over 3,800 international students, along with 272 active H-1B employees and 120 J-1 scholars, from 125 countries.** We offer more than 40 programs annually, all designed to build community across the populations we serve.

Grounding our advisement, programming, processes, and data collection in research and best practices ensures that we are delivering the services that our students and scholars want and need. Aligning these initiatives with The Office of Global Engagement, and the 2030 strategic plan of Boundless Possibility positions us to consistently live our Meliora values.

The Center for Education Abroad (CEA) advances the University of Rochester's global mission by providing the tools and resources students and faculty need to gain global perspective, expand horizons, and make their world ever better.

**CEA provides academically rigorous programs in over 40 countries**, helping students from all majors integrate global experiences into their degree plans while staying on track to graduate. They also administer the incoming student exchange program to foster a vibrant campus and future collaborations. Additionally, CEA partners with faculty to develop high-impact programs that strengthen teaching, research, and the University of Rochester's global footprint. CEA also supports global mobility initiatives across all schools, proactively manages risk and student safety

through comprehensive pre-departure orientation, and tracks all University of Rochester-related international travel to protect both students and the institution.

# 2014 to Present Formalization and Expansion

The University of Rochester's commitment to global engagement was solidified with the establishment of the Office for Global Engagement (GLOBAL) in 2014. This office provided strategic leadership and coordination for the University's international initiatives, further enhancing its global presence and influence. Under the leadership of Jane Gatewood, the first Vice Provost for Global Engagement, the office expanded its initiatives, focusing on significantly enhancing services for international students, faculty, scholars, and staff, broadening education abroad services for students and faculty, and establishing new international partnerships.

By 2018, the international student population had grown to over 3,200, representing nearly 30% of the total student body and over 130 different countries. The University's global partnerships also flourished, including collaborations with over 100 international institutions, student exchanges, joint

The Office for Global Engagement also played a crucial role in expanding support services for international students, faculty, scholars, and staff, ensuring they had the resources they needed to thrive at the University.

These priorities support and align with the broader goals outlined in the University of Rochester's Boundless Possibility: 2030 Strategic Plan. This visionary framework guides the institution toward strengthening research excellence and global reputation, reimagining exceptional undergraduate and graduate education, expanding

and transforming health care delivery, fostering faculty and staff success, and ensuring sustainable growth. This alignment ensures that the University is well-positioned to frame and solve the greatest challenges of the future.

This period also saw several significant initiatives that further solidified the University of Rochester's global footprint:

- **Commitment to Academic Freedom and Support for At-Risk Scholars:** The University of Rochester is a distinguished member of the Scholars at Risk (SAR) Network and the New University in Exile Consortium (NUEC), reflecting its dedication to protecting threatened scholars and promoting global academic freedom. As part of the SAR Network, Rochester collaborates with institutions worldwide to provide refuge and support to scholars facing persecution due to their research or advocacy. Through its involvement in the NUEC, Rochester offers temporary academic positions and fosters a network dedicated to safeguarding at-risk scholars.

Additionally, as an institutional member of the Institute of International Education (IIE), the University of Rochester participates in the IIE's Scholar Rescue Fund® and the Artist Protection Fund (APF), providing fellowship grants to threatened scholars and artists globally. These affiliations collectively underscore the University's commitment to creating a safe and inclusive environment for scholars and artists in need.

This period also marked the launch of the University's first Global Awards in 2024 and the formalization of plans for Global Celebration Week in 2027, alongside an expanded International Education Week. These landmark initiatives have significantly advanced the University's internationalization efforts, strengthening engagement with both internal and external partners and reinforcing our commitment to expanding our global footprint and enhancing collaboration across borders.



Over 1,000 international delegations from higher education, government, and civil society have engaged with the University during this period, meeting with our experts to gain insights and learn about our leading research and programs.



The University of Rochester has in-country representatives in India, China, and Vietnam.



The University of Rochester maintains a robust connection with the Fulbright Program, the flagship international educational exchange initiative sponsored by the U.S. Department of State's Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs, which supports academic and cultural exchange worldwide.
