





EcoReps Responsibilities:

- * Organizing campus events and hall programs
 - * Attending class twice a week.
- * Updating EcoBoards twice a semester
- * Developing a year-long committee project targeting sustainability issues on campus
- *Participating in 2-3 sustainability events put on by other Green Groups (per semester)
- * Attending two semesters of CAS 303: EcoReps and Sustainability; a two credit graded course that will help teach the EcoReps to ask thought-provoking questions and come to their own conclusions about sustainable solutions
- * EcoReps move-in early August 2019 for 3 days of training
