Rates are offered in two categories: by the summer session or short-term stay by the week; one week minimum. All stays must begin 5/18. **Once a student leaves housing, they are not eligible to return to housing.**We do <u>not</u> offer a per night rate.

## **Short-Term Stays**

There is a one week minimum for staying on campus during the summer. All dates must start on 5/18. Student may indicate a specific end date. Summer housing staff will calculate the rate based on the number of weeks housing is needed. Important notes:

First Week rate: (one week stay only)

\$170.00 (Monday – Saturday)

Second Week and beyond weekly rate: (multiple weeks)

\$161.00 (Sunday – Saturday)

### **Bridge Contract**

Bridge contracts cover the period from the end of your Summer Housing Contract, to the start of your 2020-2021 housing contract. Students must be have a fall 2020 housing contract and are in a full summer session to be eligible for a bridge contract. All other summer residents must leave campus housing by Saturday, 8/8/2020.
