This was the final Genesee Staff Council (GSC) meeting of the 2023-24 academic year. Topics of discussion included: the GSC election; CPM progress and updates; the creation of handoff documents for a smooth transition of work. The group engaged in breakout sessions for their respective committees and districts, with a focus on cleaning up documents for the September orientation and future committee meetings. Lastly, Jon Powers, co-chair, acknowledged the contributions of departing council members, and asked those who were leaving to say a few words.

GSC Elections

- Reminder that the co-chair elections will be held in September instead of October
- Council members to help recruit nominees for open positions in Hajim School of Engineering and Auxiliary Union districts
- Amanda to create and share recording about GSC history and structure for orientation

CPM Discussion / Improving Appeals Process

- Requests for HR:
 - o Add more obvious navigation to the CPM appeals page from the HR homepage
 - o Update website with clearer information on how to find HR Business Partners
 - o Make CPM leveling guide public after creating required training
 - o Publish more detailed information about the benchmarking process and the limitations of using self-reported data for salary studies
 - o Address concerns about equity due to wage compression

Handoff Documents / Orientation Preparation

- Focus on the creation of handoff documents for committees and districts to ensure a smooth transition
 - Separated into breakout groups to discuss work that has been done this term, plans for next academic year, tips for new GSC members
- Reconvened to share thoughts and experiences from the past year and preview the coming year
