UR Workplace Success: Advantages and opportunities hiring from the refugee community

Jeff shared insights about environmental health projects and refugee support programs at the University of Rochester, highlighting successful outcomes and areas for improvement in supporting refugee communities.

Refugee Health and Community Engagement

Jeff discussed their work connecting communities through environmental and public health outreach, particularly focusing on the impact of animal health on human health and the environment. He shared a successful project involving the reintroduction of sturgeon into the Genesee River, which led to community engagement with refugee populations.

Jeff reviewed the different pathways for refugees and asylum seekers, including the lengthy process for asylum seekers and the support provided by organizations like Rochester Refugee Resettlement Services.

Jeff discussed the benefits of University of Rochester's hiring and support of refugees and asylum seekers.

Open Floor :

Engagement/Communications/Internal Affairs - plans for increasing voter turnout

Updates were shared on plans to increase voter turnout, including a communications plan and in-person events. A "Tasty Tuesday" event was announced for July 8th to coincide with the nomination period, featuring a GSC table with a QR code for nominations.

Annual Report Update

The annual report was sent on to the Executive Committee with a target completion date in early July.

An ice cream social event organized by the AS&E district was discussed highlighting its success (86 attendees!) and potential for replication by other districts.
